



NOTICE TO RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES ON TROWER AVE – NAPA CA

Dear Sir or Madam,

The City of Napa has awarded Northern Pacific, Inc. a contract for the Trower Avenue Rehabilitation Project. Work will take place on Trower Ave. at two locations. The first location will be between Dry Creek Road and Linda Vista Ave and the second location will be between Jefferson St and Hwy 29. The funding comes from Napa County's new Measure T half-cent sales tax, which takes effect on July 1, 2018. This is the first Napa street to benefit from this new source of funding.

From Dry Creek Road to Linda Vista Ave, the work will consist of curb & gutter and sidewalk repairs, tree removals and replacements.

From Hwy 29 to Jefferson St, the work will consist of cold in-place recycling of existing pavement, hot-mix asphalt overlay, streetlight and sidewalk improvements.

The portion of the work in your area is scheduled to start on: **7/25/2018**

The work in this area should be completed by: **12/1/2018**

barring adverse weather or unforeseen conditions.

Regular working hours will be between the hours of 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. weekdays, except holidays.

DURING SCHOOL HOURS, ANY LANE CLOSURES WILL BE LIMITED TO THE HOURS 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

No utility service interruptions are anticipated at this time; however, both the utility owner and you will be notified in the event of any outage caused by construction operations.

During construction, traffic controls will be implemented and No Parking/Tow Away zones will be posted and enforced. However, access for block residents, businesses deliveries, public transit, garbage collection, and emergency services will be maintained at all times.

For everyone's safety, we ask for your help in limiting the use of roadways within the construction areas during working hours, and to park in driveways or on adjacent blocks when No Parking Zones are posted.

Noise levels may be increased at times, and some inconvenience may be unavoidable. But we are committed to do whatever we can to minimize impact from construction activities.
