Dear Property Owner/Resident,

We have evaluated the City Street Tree adjacent to your property as part of curb, gutter, and/or sidewalk repairs planned for the Westwood Neighborhood Rehabilitation Phase 1 Project. The City of Napa's goal is to preserve all Street Trees and removal will be determined on a case by case basis. The street work is scheduled to begin during the month of August/September.

Trees requiring removal will have a yellow Public Notice tree removal placard attached to the trunk facing the street. These tree removals are being performed as part of this city project. They either have been found to be causing damage to public infrastructure or the tree is causing persistent sidewalk and ADA safety concerns in addition to being in poor health or at the end of their life. These issues cannot be mitigated by practical and reasonable options as determined by an arborist.

Areas of very extensive tree root pruning required to repair the curb, gutter and sidewalk will necessitate some tree removals. Removal of a significant portion of the anchoring roots would likely result in tree failure. Municipal Code Section 12.44.030 requires that a replacement tree is to be planted by the City for any tree removed provided there is adequate space and no conflicts with utilities.

We will be replanting these trees with Acer Buergeraum (Trident Maple) and Acer Rubrum (Red Maple).

If you have any landscape plants, planters or hardscape improvements such as rock, brick or pavers in the planter strip adjacent to the tree (that you would like to save), we ask that you remove those materials in advance of our work.

Estimados residentes y propietarios del vecindario de Westwood:

La Ciudad ha evaluado los árboles en frente de su propiedad como parte de las mejoras de pavimento, bordo, y banqueta en la area de la vecindad de Westwood. La Ciudad intentara preservar los arboles cuando posible. La construcción empesarar en Agosto o' Septiembre.

Los árboles que serán eliminados estarán marcados con un aviso amarillo. Los árboles marcados serán eliminados para construir las mejoras de concreto o' porque están causando problemas con la infraestructura existente. El Código Municipal 12.44.030 requiere que un árbol será plantado por cada árbol eliminado en donde hay suficiente espacio y no hay conflictos con los servicios públicos.

Los árboles plantados seran tipo Acer Buergeraum (Trident Maple) y tipo Acer Rubrum (Red Maple).

Si tienen plantas, arbustos, cercas, caminos de ladrillo o' otras decoraciones que quieren salvar y se encuentran entre 4 pies detras de el bordillo existente, les pedimos que mueven los materiales en avance de construcción.
