Suspect: James Curtis Faulkenberry 30 Years Napa Resident



On November 17th 2018, around 11:11 p.m., the Napa Police Department received 9-1-1 calls regarding a fight in progress at Stone's Sports Bar & Lounge, 1679 W Imola Ave, Napa, Ca. involving male and female patrons. Napa Police patrol officers responded to the scene and located a female patron, who had been physically attacked by two males inside the bar. The fight continued outside of the front entrance to the bar. The female victim was knocked unconscious during the assault. The two suspects, a White male adult and Hispanic male adult, fled prior to the patrol officers' arrival. Several victims were treated by the Napa Fire Department at the scene and the female victim was transported by American Medical Response to an area hospital for treatment.

Napa Police Investigations followed up on the case and as a result of their investigation obtained warrants for the arrest of both James Curtis Faulkenberry and Juan Rojas. Since the attack, Rojas turned himself in on November 21st, 2018 and is currently in custody at the Napa County Department of Corrections on \$150,000 bail. James Faulkenberry is aware he has a warrant for his arrest and is currently refusing to turn himself in. James Faulkenberry has tattoos on both arms and neck. If you see him, please do not approach him as he should be considered dangerous. We ask that you call 9-1-1.
