On 12/29/18 a vehicle's side window was broken out and a purse stolen in the Healthquest Fitness Center parking lot. The victim's credit cards were used at Target Bel Aire and Walmart in Napa amongst other places. An off-duty officer had observed a suspicious female in the Healthquest parking lot and noted her plate. After the burglary, he provided the info to the Napa officers. The suspect vehicle was registered out of Antioch. Using the security footage from the two stores, Napa detectives was able to identify the female as Briana Tyasha Williams out of Fairfield, CA. Williams was identified from the surveillance photos using the stolen cards as the owner of the vehicle seen at Healthquest.

Detectives located the suspect vehicle at the Fairfield address and a search warrant was obtained. Williams was located inside the residence and arrested for 459 Vehicle Burglary-Felony, 459 Commercial Burglary-Felony, 484 G Theft of Access Card- Felony, and 530.5 Identity Theft-Felony.

The victim's cell phone and numerous gift cards were recovered. Williams was brought back and booked into the Napa Department of Corrections.
