TO SOLICIT INPUT FROM THE PUBLIC REGARDING THE CONTENT OF DRAFT DISTRICT
BOUNDARY MAPS FOR A DISTRICT-BASED ELECTION SYSTEM FOR
COUNCILMEMBERS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on March 17, 2020 at or after 6:30 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, City Hall, 955 School Street, Napa, California, a public hearing will be conducted by the City Council of the City of Napa at which time and place all persons may attend and be heard for the purpose of receiving public comment and input on the content of draft district boundary maps, and the proposed sequence of elections, for a district-based election system for Councilmembers.

On February 11, 2020, the City Council adopted a resolution declaring the City of Napa's intent to transition from at-large elections to district-based elections for Councilmembers, outlined specific steps to facilitate the transition, and estimated a timeframe for the transition.

On February 25, 2020 and March 4, 2020, the City Council held its first and second Public Hearings to receive input on the composition of district boundaries for a district-based election system for Councilmembers.

On March 17, 2020, the City Council will hold its third Public Hearing to receive additional input on the content of draft district boundary maps, and the proposed sequence of elections, for a district-based election system for Councilmembers. The public hearing on March 17, 2020 will include a presentation of the draft district boundary maps and proposed sequence of elections, and provide the opportunity to receive and consider further input from the public. Said maps will

be posted seven days in advance on March 10, 2020 on the City's website at www.cityofnapa.org/districtelections.
