**Offense:** Criminal threats, conspiracy to commit a crime

On the evening of 9/19/2021 the Napa Police Department received a report of threats that occurred via social media messaging. The person targeted by these threats is a student at Harvest Middle School.

Upon receiving this report, Officers began an investigation to determine who was responsible for making the threats. On 9/20/2021 Officers identified two suspects who were determined to be responsible for the threats. Due to the fact the involved parties were juveniles, their identities are being withheld.

Currently, there does not appear to be a credible threat to the individual targeted student or Harvest Middle School. The Napa Police Department is still completing its investigation into this incident.

We would like to thank everyone who had the courage to come forward and report this incident. We would also like to thank the Napa Valley Unified School District for their assistance, and in making student safety a priority.
