Turf Replacement Rebate Program

Convert to a Water-Efficient Landscape!

The City of Napa is offering cash rebates to water customers who replace thirsty turfgrass with drip-irrigated low-water-use plants or permeable hardscape materials. Artificial turf installations are not eligible for the rebate. Funding is limited and applications will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Program is budgeted through June 2019, but the City reserves the right to terminate this program at any time, for any reason.

Rebate Offer

\$1.00 per square foot of turf removed, with per site maximum of:

\$750 for Single-Family Residential (equivalent to 750 sq. ft.)

\$2,500 for Commercial/Multi-Family (equivalent to 2,500 sq. ft.)

Customers may of course remove more lawn area than is covered by the rebate program, but the per site maximum \$ will still apply.

Customers must consent to **brief Pre- and Post-Inspection site visits** by City of Napa Water Conservation staff in order to apply and qualify for the Cash For Grass rebate.

At the **Pre-Inspection** visit, City staff will measure the proposed conversion area and verify that the site meets the program's terms and conditions. If approved, the City will mail a **Notice to Proceed** to the customer.

Lawn conversions **must be completed within four (4) months** of the Notice to Proceed. To ensure water savings are achieved, the converted area must remain in compliance with program terms and conditions for a **period of five (5) years** following receipt of the rebate. An applicant may be charged part or all of the rebate amount at the City's discretion if the terms or conditions have been violated. Notwithstanding the foregoing, this requirement is void upon transfer of ownership.

Following the **Post-Inspection** visit and **Final Approval**, the City will issue rebate check to the eligible applicant within **four (4) weeks**.

Terms and Conditions

- Program is open to all properties served by a **City of Napa water account**. Applicant's account must be in good standing.
- Lawn areas to be converted must be historically maintained in healthy condition, and be irrigated by a sprinkler system in working condition. *Long-dead lawns or lawns already removed at the time of pre-inspection are not eligible for rebate.*
- **Landscaping Requirements for Converted Area:**
 - Plants** - must be drought tolerant and adapted to our climate. Helpful resources for water-wise plant selection are available at www.cityofnapa.org/water. All planting areas must have a minimum of three (3) inches of mulch.
 - Hardscape** - must be permeable (e.g., decomposed granite). Impermeable surfaces such as concrete are not allowed in the rebated portion of the converted area.
- **NOTE: Artificial Turf** is not allowed in the rebated portion of the converted landscape as it does not meet the definition of sustainable landscaping in State grant funding agreements. (This rebate program is currently supported by a Prop 84 Grant from the California Department of Water Resources.)
- **Irrigation system** for the converted area, if used, must be **low-volume drip**. The system must be in good working order, free of leaks and malfunctions. If only part of a lawn is converted, new planting area must be irrigated on a separate valve from the remaining lawn. Sprinkler system for the remaining lawn must be modified to avoid spray onto the converted area.
- **Tenants/Renters:** If applicant is not the property owner, written consent from the property owner must be provided to City staff at the Pre-Inspection visit.
- At Post-Inspection, applicant must provide a **list** of plants and hardscape materials used in the conversion (may be handwritten) along with **receipts for costs incurred**. If conversion fails inspection, applicant will be given thirty (30) days to bring project into compliance.
- Offer is limited to **one** Cash For Grass rebate per account.

Steps to Participate

1. Call the City of Napa Water Conservation Specialist at (707) 257-9497 to schedule a brief Pre-Inspection visit to have the lawn area measured.
2. Following Pre-Inspection, await receipt of Notice to Proceed letter and pre-approved Application from the City. *Do not remove lawn until you receive these documents.*
3. Remove the lawn area and install your project according to the program Terms and Conditions. *Find helpful resources in the Water Conservation section at www.cityofnapa.org/water.*
4. Call the City of Napa Water Conservation Specialist at (707) 257-9497 to schedule a Post-Inspection visit. *Post-Inspection must take place within 4 months of the Notice to Proceed.*
5. Provide at Post-Inspection your final completed Application, a list of plants and materials used in the conversion, and copies of receipts for costs incurred. *Rebate checks will be processed within 4 weeks.*
