City of Napa requires an approved permit and certificate of insurance for all commercial boating at any of the municipal boat docks or boat launching areas including John F. Kennedy Park Boat Dock, 100 Riverside Drive Boat Launch, Jim Hench Memorial Kayak Launch at Oxbow Commons, and Trancas Crossing Boat Launch. Any commercial operators using the Main Street Boat Dock will need an approved landing rights agreement with Tideline Marine Group. No alcohol can be served or consumed without additional approved permit and subject to additional insurance and fees. A permit is required each year and available starting December 1st for the following year. The Parks & Recreation Department reserves the right to limited the number of commercial operators at each location and permitted hours of use.
