Summary:

On October 7, 2018 at about 10:51 p.m. Napa Police Department Patrol Officers were dispatched to a solo vehicle traffic collision that occurred on McKinstry Street. The first arriving Police Officer found an adult male lying in the street and a vehicle associated with the collision in the 1200 block of McKinstry Street. The male was unconscious and sustained major injuries. He was transported by medical personnel to an area hospital where he succumbed to his injuries and was pronounced deceased. The identity of the deceased is not being released at this time. Please contact the Napa County Coroner for further information.

The Napa Police Department Accident Reconstruction Team and Napa Police Department Investigations were activated and are investigating the incident. The investigation will look into the circumstances of the collision and whether drugs or alcohol contributed to this collision. All the involved parties were cooperative and interviewed.

McKinstry Street was closed between First Street and the Westin Hotel for four hours while investigators processed the scene.
