	<b>California Fuchsia</b>	Zauschneria californica	shrubby perennial	1 x 4 ft	orange/red	Summer/Fall	California native is a hummingbird magnet	occasional soaking in summer	plant in the fall, water deeply then let the winter rains settle it in
	<b>Finger Aloe</b>	Cotyledon orbiculata var. oblonga 'Flavida'	succulent	2 x 4 ft	chalky gray/pale orange	Spring/Summer	South African succulent spreads out to form small low shrub or groundcover	occasional but infrequent irrigation once established	deep watering every 4-6 weeks in summer should suffice
	<b>Golden Yarrow</b>	Achillea 'Coronation Gold'	perennial	3 x 1.5 ft	golden yellow	Spring/Summer/Fall	bright yellow flower attracts birds and butterflies	needs only occasional watering once established	let dry out between waterings, check the soil
	<b>Sunset Manzanita</b>	Arctostaphylos 'Sunset'	mounding shrub	5 x 5 ft	pink/white	Winter	rapid growth, tolerates wide range of soils and garden conditions	monthly deep water to establish first two spring/summers	once established over a couple summers can cut back to watering 1 -2 times across the summer
	<b>Butterfly Bush</b>	Buddleja davidii 'Black Knight'	shrub	up to 15 x 15 ft	purple	Summer	beautiful purple flowering shrub attracts butterflies	needs only occasional watering once established	If you water a lot it will get huge. Don't do it!
	<b>Wooly Grevillea</b>	Grevillea lanigera 'Coastal Gem'	evergreen shrub	1 x 4 ft	pink	Spring	attracts hummingbirds	little to no watering once established	plant in the fall, water deeply then let the winter rains settle it in
	<b>Prostrate Myoporum</b>	Myoporum parvifolium (white)	evergreen groundcover	1 x 8 ft	white	Summer	beautiful white flowering groundcover is great deer-resistant plant option	very low water most of year, extra in summer	plant in the fall, water deeply then let the winter rains settle it in
	<b>Red Hot Poker</b>	Kniphofia 'Shining Scepter'	perennial	3 x 1 ft	orange	Summer	attracts hummingbirds	low watering once established	plant in the fall, water deeply then let the winter rains settle it in
	<b>Jupiter's Beard</b>	Centranthus ruber (red)	perennial	3 x 3 ft	pink/red	Spring/Summer	great choice for drought tolerant, deer-resistant plant	very low water most of year, extra in summer	plant in the fall, water deeply then let the winter rains settle it in
	<b>Toyon</b>	Heteromeles arbutifolia	tree	up to 25 x 5 ft	white flower/red berry	Spring/Summer (Fall/Winter berry)	California native tree attracts beneficial insects, hummingbirds	low watering once established	let dry out between waterings, check the soil
	<b>Century Plant</b>	Agave americana	succulent	up to 8 x 12 ft	gray green leaves	N/A	flowers just once, at the end of its long life	little to no watering once established	Agaves store water in their leaves and can handle a drought, but don't let them freeze!
