TO SOLICIT INPUT FROM THE PUBLIC REGARDING THE COMPOSITION OF DISTRICT
BOUNDARIES FOR A DISTRICT-BASED ELECTION SYSTEM FOR COUNCILMEMBERS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on March 4, 2020 at or after 6:30 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, City Hall, 955 School Street, Napa, California, a public hearing will be conducted by the City Council of the City of Napa at which time and place all persons may attend and be heard for the purpose of receiving public comment and input on the composition of district boundaries for a district-based election system for Councilmembers.

On February 11, 2020, the City Council adopted a resolution declaring the City of Napa's intent to transition from at-large elections to district-based elections for Councilmembers, outlined specific steps to facilitate the transition, and estimated a timeframe for the transition.

On February 25, 2020, the City Council will hold its first Public Hearing to receive input on the composition of district boundaries for a district-based election system for Councilmembers.

On March 4, 2020, the City Council will hold its second Public Hearing to receive additional input on the composition of district boundaries for a district-based election system for Councilmembers.
